Pursuant to Section 7.3 of the First Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA") approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") by Order No. 07-564 (December 19, 2007), the Klamath Water Users Association ("KWUA") hereby requests final payment of KWUA's Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UE 210 in the amount of \$6,636.40.

On April 21, 2009, KWUA filed a Notice of Intent to Request an Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UE 210. On June 1, 2009, KWUA filed a proposed budget in the amount of \$40,000 in Docket No. UE 210. The Commission approved an Issue Fund Grant for KWUA in the amount of \$26,870 on June 18, 2009. Re PacifiCorp, OPUC Docket No. UE 210, Order No. 09-227 (June 18, 2009). As a result, KWUA has an approved Issue Fund grant of \$26,870 in this proceeding. On August 20, 2009, KWUA filed a Request for Partial Payment of Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$20,233.60, which was approved on August 28, 2009. Re PacifiCorp, OPUC Docket No. UE210, Order NO. 09-334 (August 28, 2009).

KWUA hereby requests that the Commission authorize final payment of the Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$6,636.40. KWUA's expenses are shown in Confidential Attachment A. None of the expenses shown in Attachment A were included in KWUA's PAGE 1 – REQUEST FOR FINAL PAYMENT OF ISSUE FUND GRANT OF KWUA

Request for Partial Payment.

This Request for Payment satisfies the requirements of the IFA as follows:

<u>Section 7.3(a)</u> – The itemized expenses, payees, and hourly rates are attached as Confidential Exhibit A.

Section 7.3(b) – KWUA has been a full and active participant in this Docket. KWUA conducted discovery, filed direct testimony, and has participated in workshops and settlement discussions. The expenses included in Confidential Exhibit A are reasonable and directly attributable to KWUA's participation in Docket No. UE 210.

Section 7.3(c) – The Commission approved KWUA's proposed budget on June 18, 2009. In addition, KWUA used its own funds to pay for well over 20% of the Eligible Expenses as required by Section 6.5 of the IFA.

Section 7.4 – All of the expenses included in Exhibit A are Eligible Expenses as defined in Section 7.4 of the IFA because they relate to services provided or expenses incurred by KWUA's outside legal counsel and expert witnesses. Relevant non-privileged documents substantiating the Eligible Expenses in Confidential Exhibit A are available for Commission audit, if requested, pursuant to Section 7.10 of the IFA.

The IFA provides that the granting of "an Issue Fund Grant shall constitute a binding obligation on the Commission to order reimbursement of Eligible Expenses." IFA § 6.5. Likewise, the intervenor funding rules adopted by the Commission provide that "the terms of an [intervenor funding] agreement will be binding on all organizations seeking a grant under that agreement and will be followed by the Commission in administering the agreement." OAR § 860-012-0100(2). KWUA has satisfied the terms of the IFA and respectfully requests that the Commission approve final payment of KWUA's Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$6,636.40 within 30 days of receiving this Request for Final Payment as provided in Section 7.6 of the IFA. This Request for Payment constitutes a Final Request for Payment in this docket.
