PacifiCorp, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, and Sempra ("Settling Parties") are pleased to inform you that they have reached a comprehensive settlement in principle in this case.

The Settling Parties propose to file a Stipulation documenting their settlement by Wednesday, July 7, 2010. The Settling Parties also propose the following changes to the procedural schedule to reflect their settlement.

First, under the Stipulation, PacifiCorp would not file Rebuttal Testimony, but would file its Rebuttal Update, consistent with the TAM Guidelines adopted in Order No. 09-274 and modified in Order No. 09-432. The Parties agree that PacifiCorp will file its Rebuttal Update concurrently with the filing of the Stipulation. The Parties therefore propose to suspend the current July 2, 2010 date for the filing of PacifiCorp's Rebuttal Testimony and Rebuttal Update.

Second, the Settling Parties propose to use the dates currently in the schedule for surrebuttal and sur-surrebuttal testimony as filing dates for testimony responding to the Rebuttal Update, as necessary. While the need for a hearing on the Rebuttal Update seems unlikely, the hearing date could also be retained in the calendar for use if necessary. The current schedule on the Final Updates remains unchanged under the Stipulation.

The Settling Parties propose to file Joint Testimony in support of the Stipulation separately from the filing of the Stipulation later in July 2010.
