

Pacific Power files for Oregon rate change

On March 1, 2012, Pacific Power filed a **general rate case** with the Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC), requesting recovery of capital investments and other operating costs. If approved, the request would result in an overall net increase of \$41.2 million, or 3.5 percent. The increase to residential, medium general service, and irrigation customers would be approximately 3.5 percent; the increase to large general service customers would be approximately 4.4 percent; and the increase to small general service and street lighting customers would be approximately 2.0 percent.

The primary purpose and need of the filing is to recover costs of providing service for ongoing new investments in the electrical system, to continue providing safe, reliable electricity for our customers, and to comply with regulatory mandates.

If approved by the OPUC, a residential customer using 950 kilowatt-hours will see a monthly bill increase of approximately \$3.78 effective with service on and after January 1, 2013. Pacific Power serves approximately 580,000 customers in Oregon.

We understand the impact that price increases have on our customers and work to mitigate the impacts as much as possible.
