AMENDMENT OF PROPOSED BUDGET OF THE CITIZENS' UTILITY BOARD OF OREGON

Pursuant to Section 6.7 of the Second Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement (Agreement), which was adopted in Order No. 12-452, the Citizens' Utility Board submits this Amendment of Proposed Budget in docket UE 262 from the Portland General Electric (PGE) Issue Fund. CUB is automatically precertified under Section 5.2 of the Agreement.

On April 15, 2013, CUB submitted a proposed budget showing eligible expenses of \$100,025 and seeking an Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$80,020. On April 22, 2013, in Order No. 13-146, the Commission approved CUB's budget.

Section 6.7 of the Agreement states:

<u>Amendment of Proposed Budget</u>: At any time during the proceeding, an intervenor who received Commission approval for an Issue Fund Grant may file to amend its budget and request additional funding due to unforeseen changes in the scope or complexity of issues, positions taken by other parties, changes in the schedule of the case, or other good cause.

There is good cause to support approving CUB's proposed budget amendment. As indicated in CUB's proposed budget filed on April 15, 2013, its budget showed eligible expenses of more than \$100,000. On July 24, 2013, CUB filed for a progress payment in the amount of \$60,000, which was approved by the Commission on August 6, 2013 in Order No. 13-290. CUB has since exceeded its approved budget of \$80,020 in this docket,¹ in part due to the complexity of the remaining issue in this docket. Since CUB's progress payment, CUB has conducted additional discovery, and drafted and filed its final round of testimony. CUB must still review PGE's upcoming final round of testimony, prepare for a hearing and oral argument, and draft legal briefs. Each of these tasks will require substantial additional time and resources.

CUB's recent request for final payment and release of excess funds in dockets UM 1182 and UE 266, totaling \$17,839.40, provides additional funds in PGE's Issue Fund to accommodate CUB's current request. Therefore, CUB is seeking to increase its approved budget to \$97,859. CUB's amended budget accompanies this document as Attachment A.
