Pursuant to Section 7.3 of the Fourth Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA") approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in Order No. 18-017 (January 17, 2018), the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers ("AWEC") hereby requests final payment of AWEC's Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UE 352 in the amount of \$35,119.92.

On January 30, 2019, AWEC filed a Request for Issue Fund Grant and Proposed

Article 6.5. Likewise, the intervenor funding rules adopted by the Commission provide that

"[t]he terms of an [intervenor funding] agreement are binding on all organizations seeking a

grant under that agreement and will be followed by the Commission in administering the

agreement." OAR § 860-001-0120(2). AWEC has satisfied the terms of the IFA and
