Re: AR 614 - UE 358 New Large Load Direct Access (NLDA) Compliance Filing; Affidavit of New Large Load Eligibility Requirements and Status Reporting

Portland General Electric Company's (PGE) submits in compliance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-038-0730(2)(a), the Affidavit of New Large Load Eligibility Requirements from New Large Load Direct Access participant. The Affidavit is provided as Attachment A and considered Confidential under General Protective Order No. 19-175.

As a result of an internal compliance audit, it was discovered that PGE inadvertently did not file the customer signed New Large Load agreement of the Affidavit of Eligibility which was fully executed in July 2021.

In addition, this filing also serves as PGE's Status Reporting pursuant to OAR 860-038-0760 for reporting of the following:

*Each electric company must file a status report to the Commission within two months of total enrollment in New Large Load Direct Access Programs reaching 25 average megawatts, 50 average megawatts, 100 average megawatts, and 80 percent of any enrollment limit adopted by the Commission.*

PGE has two customers enrolled at 117MW and reporting enrollment at the 100 MWa threshold.

AFFIDAVIT OF ELIGIBILITY AND COMPLIANCE

I further represent that, throughout the duration of its enrollment under Schedule 689, [REDACTED] shall fully comply with its obligations under OAR 860-038-0730(1) by contracting for energy resources that do not include any allocation of coal-fired resources, as defined in ORS 757.518 (1)(b)(A), after January

1, 2030. Furthermore, it is understood that violation of this commitment could result in disenrollment from Schedule 689 service.

5. I understand that Portland General Electric Company is obligated to, and shall provide a copy of this Affidavit of Eligibility and Compliance to the Public Utility Commission of Oregon pursuant to OAR 860-038-0730(2)(a).
6. If any of my statements in this Affidavit is false, I acknowledge that the consequence could be disenrollment from Schedule 689 in addition to any other remedies that PGE may seek to enforce against [REDACTED]
