Filing Center,

Enclosed is PGE's November 5, 2021, MONET update for Docket No. UE 391. This update includes contracts and electric and gas forward curves as of October 14, 2021. PGE's Net Variable Power Cost (NVPC) forecast for 2022 totals approximately \$543.8 million, an increase of approximately \$25.1 million from the October 1, 2021 power cost update filing.¹ This increase is primarily due to electric and gas forward price curves, and fuel and power contract updates. The power cost increases are partially offset by updates to PGE's term contracts and the EIM net benefit.
