**RE:** UE 391 – PGE Minimum Filing Requirements

Dear Filing Center,

Commission Order No. 08-505 in Docket No. UE 198 adopted a list of Minimum Filing Requirements (MFRs) for Net Variable Power Cost (NVPC) proceedings. The MFRs define the documents PGE will provide in conjunction with the initial and update filings in its Annual Power Cost Update Tariff and general rate case proceedings.

Prepared for submission to the PUC are PGE's MFRs for our initial 2021 Annual Power Cost Update Tariff filing submitted April 1, 2021 in Docket No. UE 391. The MFRs submitted in conjunction with the April 1, 2021 filing include supporting documents and work papers for the enhancements and new items included in the initial 2021 Annual Power Cost Update Tariff filing. The remaining MFRs that will include forward curve inputs, load inputs, thermal plant inputs, hydro inputs, electric and gas contract inputs, wheeling inputs, wind power inputs, ancillary services, and historical operating data will be submitted on April 15, 2021.
