

### What this General Rate Case Won't Address

- New HB 2475 and Docket UM 2211 Energy Justice Programs
  - However, Staff will view PGE's filing with an Energy Justice Lens.
- Broad State Environmental Programs or Building Electrification
  - However, Staff will review green energy projects for prudent management and efficient cost control.







- Work in teams and also individually on rate case issues.

- Paired with Attorney from DOJ





- Analyze Company filing
- Send requests for information
- Submit and defend written testimony
- Review all testimony submitted by other parties and assess reasonableness
- Develop settlement positions
  - Other parties get advance notice to any settlement meeting staff intends to attend
- Cross examine other witnesses
- Submit legal briefs
