On August 6, 2018, Northwest Natural Gas Company ("NW Natural" or the "Company"), the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("Staff"), Oregon Citizens' Utility Board ("CUB") and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers ("AWEC") (together, the "Stipulating Parties") filed a Partial Stipulation, proposing an agreed upon resolution to various issues in this case. Under the terms of the Partial Stipulation, NW Natural agreed to file an attestation of a Company officer by October 5, 2018, attesting to whether any projects forecast to cost over \$1,000,000 and to be completed by October 31, 2018 will not be complete by this time. Pursuant to the Partial Stipulation, if the Company's identifies any projects that will not be complete by October 31, 2018, those projects will be removed from rate base for purposes of calculating the rates pursuant to the Partial Stipulation, and rates adjusted accordingly.

In accordance with the Partial Stipulation, NW Natural files with this letter the attestation of Kimberly A. Heiting, Senior Vice President, Utility Operations and Chief Marketing Officer. Ms. Heiting's Attestation identifies three projects included in the rate case that will not be completed by October 31, 2018. The total costs for these projects, inclusive of construction overhead, is \$6.619 million. As such, this amount will be removed from rate base for purposes of calculating rates pursuant to the Partial Stipulation. The Company's compliance filing following a Commission Order on the Partial Stipulation will show the updated revenue requirements effect of this change to rate base and the resulting rates for customers.
