NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST AN ISSUE FUND GRANT OF THE INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS OF NORTHWEST UTILITIES

The Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU") files this Notice of Intent to Request an Issue Fund Grant in UM 1050, pursuant to OAR § 860-017-0050 and the First Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA"), approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in Order No. 07-564 (December 19, 2007).

1. UM 1050 is an investigation opened to consider multi-jurisdictional issues facing PacifiCorp (or the "Company") and its customers. PacifiCorp operates in six different retail jurisdictions.

2. UM 1050 is an Eligible Proceeding under the IFA. The IFA defines an Eligible Proceeding as "any Commission proceeding that directly affects one or more of the Participating Public Utilities." IFA, Section 1(c). UM 1050 directly affects PacifiCorp, which is a Participating Public Utility under Section 1(k) of the IFA. Therefore, an Issue Fund Grant may be made for this proceeding under Section 6.1 the IFA.

3. Section 6.2 of the IFA requires a party to submit the Notice of Intent to Request Issue Fund Grant at the time that party submits a petition to intervene in the proceeding. ICNU previously submitted a petition to intervene in an earlier phase of this proceeding on March 13, 2002. Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Logan granted that petition on April 8, 2002. The Commission issued a final order in the earlier phase of the proceeding on January 12,2005.

PacifiCorp made a new filing on September 15, 2010 to reopen this proceeding. At the prehearing conference held on October 25, 2010, ALJ Tracy A. G. Kirkpatrick established that the parties must file a new notice to request intervenor funding in this docket by Friday, November 12, 2010, and must propose the corresponding issue fund budget by December 3, 2010.

4. As required by IFA Section 6.2, this Notice of Intent is being served on each affected Participating Public Utility, all precertified organizations, and all parties identified on the service list from UM 1050.

5. ICNU identifies the PacifiCorp Issue Fund Account as the account from which ICNU intends to request the Issue Fund Grant.

6. ICNU has been precertified under Sections 5.1 and 5.2 of the IFA and OAR § 860-017-0050(3), as eligible to receive an Issue Fund Grant, by Commission Order No. 08-006, which was entered on January 9, 2008.
