CUB REQUEST FOR A PACIFICORP ISSUE FUND GRANT \& PROPOSED BUDGET

The Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) requests a grant of $\$ 47,200$ from the PacifiCorp Issue Fund. This presumes a fully litigated case; settlement of some or all of the issues would likely reduce our total request for reimbursement. CUB staff will keep track of their participation by hours and activity.

CUB is precertified as per OAR 860-012-0100(3)(a). UM 1050 is an eligible proceeding under the Intervenor Funding Agreement, adopted by the Commission on December 19, 2007 in Order No. 07-564, because the proceeding directly affects PacifiCorp, a participating public utility (Agreement 1(k)). CUB filed its Notice of Intent to Request a PacifiCorp Issue Fund Grant concurrent with its Notice of Intervention, as required by the Intervenor Funding Agreement (Agreement 6.2).

Pursuant to paragraph 6.3 of the Intervenor Funding Agreement, the proposed budget must identify certain points of information. We provide the information below.
(a) Statement Of Work To Be Performed: CUB intends to participate in every procedural aspect of this case. We participated in the pre-hearing conference. We will attend and participate in all or most workshops, settlement meetings, hearings, and

Commission presentations. We will review and analyze PacifiCorp's testimony and briefs. We will review and analyze testimony and briefs filed by other parties. We will pursue discovery of PacifiCorp through data requests, and will respond to data requests asked of us. We will file testimony and briefs, and present our recommendations to the Commission.
(b)Description Of Areas To Be Investigated: CUB intends to investigate issues including, but not limited to:
A. Whether the proposed allocation methodology treats Oregon customers fairly;
B. Whether the proposed allocation methodology is consistent with previous agreements;
C. Whether the proposed allocation methodology is consistent with the ratemaking principle of limiting cost recovery to items that are "used and useful":
D. Whether the proposed allocation methodology forecasts are accurate;
E. Whether the proposed allocation methodology is allowable under Oregon statues.
(c) Description Of The Class Or Classes Benefiting From CUB's Participation:

CUB represents the interests of PacifiCorp's residential customers, though other customer classes may benefit from many aspects of our participation.
(d) The Fund From Which CUB Seeks An Issue Fund Grant \& Available Funds: CUB is seeking an issue fund grant from the PacifiCorp Issue Fund. While there is no money currently available in the PacifiCorp Issue Fund, the bulk of this case will be litigated in 2011, when $\$ 125,000$ will be available. CUB's proposed budget of $\$ 47,200$ would leave roughly $\$ 77,800$ uncommitted in the 2011PacifiCorp Issue Fund.
(e) The Budget Showing Estimated Fees And Costs: CUB's budget accompanies this document as Attachment A.
(f) A Representation Of The Use Of Matching Funds: The budget and an accounting for the use of matching funds accompanies this document as Attachment A .
