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Purpose of Workshop

This workshop will discuss how Portland General Electric and Pacific Power spend the money they receive from CFP credits. Electric Companies in Oregon generate credits from residential customers who own electric vehicles. Credits are sold to companies that sell gasoline and diesel, creating a fund for programs that promote the adoption of electricity as a motor fuel. In this workshop the utilities will present proposed spending plans for 2022. Stakeholders will provide public comment.

Launched in 2016, the CFP is run by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality to reduce the carbon intensity of Oregon's motor vehicle fuels. In Order No. 18-376, the Oregon Public Utility Commission required electric companies to participate in the CFP and present their CFP-financed programs for public review.
