Purpose of Workshop

This workshop will focus on how Portland General Electric and Pacific Power implemented feedback received at the previous workshop in their plans to spend the money received from CFP credits. Electric companies in Oregon generate credits from residential customers who own electric vehicles. Credits are sold to companies that sell gasoline and diesel, creating a fund for programs that promote the adoption of electricity as a motor fuel.

Background

Launched in 2016, the CFP is run by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality to reduce the carbon intensity of Oregon's motor vehicle fuels. In Order No. 18-376, the Oregon Public Utility Commission required electric companies to participate in the CFP and present their CFP-financed programs for public review.
