#### **Purpose of Workshop**

The Community Solar Program (CSP or Program) has initiated a review of project development hurdles and is evaluating the drivers of recent interconnection delays for CSP projects in PacifiCorp service area. Staff hopes this workshop will provide all parties with greater transparency and an opportunity for collaboration. The workshop will include a CSP interconnection queue status update and outlook provided by PacifiCorp. Stakeholders will be able to ask questions and provide clarifying information. Prior to the workshop Staff will provide a final workshop agenda and relevant information it and the PA have collected from the utility and projects.

### Background

Stakeholders have expressed concern about unexpected interconnection delays for CSP projects in PacifiCorp's service area. The Program has engaged with PacifiCorp and CSP projects to learn more about interconnection delays. The workshop is one of several steps required to
