## Summary of Recommendations - Revisions

Following discussion that occurred at the June 11 Special Public Meeting Commission Workshop in UM 2000 related to PURPA issues, Staff is planning on revising its series of suggested actions. Staff heard from parties that the timeline may be too aggressive. Staff's intent at this time is to ensure sufficient time is allocated to the issues, as well as taking advantage of information developed in other forum.

One revision will call for an investigation into the treatment of network upgrades, possibly followed by a rulemaking, as opposed to strictly a rulemaking. Any such investigation may also be informed by developments in Docket UM 1930, Community Solar Program Implementation.

Given the current timing of IRP filings, Staff intends to suggest the investigation into planning and the treatment of QFs in utility IRPs be informed by what the utilities include in their most recent IRPs. Likewise, development of avoided cost templates may be better informed by the results of UM 1893.

The rulemaking(s) related to development of a standard contract and dispute resolution would move forward as planned.

Note that each rulemaking will include an informal process for collaboration amongst the parties prior to the formal process starting. It is Staff's intent to settle as many issues as possible prior to bringing the larger policy considerations to the Commission for their decision. The table below highlights the changes noted above.
