Oregon Public Utility Commission (PUC) Staff announce an update to the Commission's plans for acting on Pacific Power and Idaho Power's DSP Part 2 filings submitted in August 2022.

- Staff will present recommendations for the Pacific Power and Idaho Power Part 2 filings during a Special Public Meeting.
- This Meeting was previously scheduled for Thursday, March 23, 2023, but has been changed to 1:30 p.m. Pacific on Tuesday, March 21, 2023.

Plans for the Special Public Meeting to consider the PGE Part 2 filing are unchanged: the Meeting will begin at 9:30 a.m. Pacific on Tuesday, February 28, 2023.

At each of these Special Public Meetings, the Commission will determine whether to accept Part 2 filings based on whether they meet the criteria and requirements of the DSP Guidelines. An agenda with additional detail and participation information will be posted closer to the event in Docket Nos. UM 2005, UM 2196, UM 2197, and UM 2198.

## **Background Information on DSP**

Oregon DSP Guidelines were developed in Docket No. <u>UM 2005</u> and adopted by the PUC through <u>Order</u> <u>No. 20-485</u>. PGE, Pacific Power, and Idaho Power filed Part 1 of their inaugural Distribution System Plans on October 15, 2021. The PUC accepted the Part 1 filings on March 11, 2022, through <u>Order No. 22-083</u>. The utilities filed Part 2 of their inaugural Plans on August 15, 2022. Links to each utility's Part 2 filing, and the respective dockets, are below.
