

Distribution System Planning Docket Announcement

Oregon Public Utility Commission (PUC) Staff announce the postponement of a Staff workshop on hosting capacity analysis (HCA). Staff planned to hold a workshop on Wednesday, October 5, 2022, with the goal of understanding stakeholders' interests in future discussions of HCA. The workshop will be rescheduled to the First Quarter 2023 and will be included in the broader discussion of revising and improving the current distribution system planning (DSP) Guidelines.

Background Information on DSP

Oregon DSP Guidelines were developed in Docket No. <u>UM 2005</u> and adopted by the PUC through <u>Order No. 20-485</u>. PGE, Pacific Power, and Idaho Power filed Part 1 of their inaugural Distribution System Plans on October 15, 2021. The PUC accepted the Part 1 filings on March 11, 2022, through <u>Order No. 22-083</u>. The utilities filed Part 2 of their inaugural Plans on August 15, 2022.
