# Docket No. UM 2005: Investigation into Distribution System Planning

Staff will be updating distribution system planning (DSP) Guidelines, adopted by the Commission in December 2020 through Order No. 20-485. Guideline updates will reflect feedback on inaugural distribution system plans (Plans) from the Commission, stakeholders, and utilities. Guideline updates based on Commissioner and stakeholder feedback to the utilities' initial distribution system plans was always part of the approach.<sup>1</sup>

<u>Scope</u>: Staff's forthcoming Guideline revisions will focus on: 1) improvements identified in utilities' inaugural Plans to refine and hone the connection between filed DSPs and investments later seen in rate cases; 2) connections between utility planning practices that have evolved or launched since DSP Guidelines were established; and 3) removal or revision of requirements for one-time activities or activities specific to inaugural Plans. DSP may result in improved understanding of interconnection challenges, which will be primarily addressed through the PUC's interconnection-related investigation, <u>Docket No. UM 2111</u>.

<u>Process</u>: Later this month Staff will publish to the docket proposed Guideline revisions and seek public comment. Staff will then present a final version to the Commission at a public meeting this summer. Staff proposes the following major steps and timeframes:

#### **Background**

PGE, Pacific Power, and Idaho Power filed Part 1 of their inaugural Distribution System Plans on October 15, 2021. The utilities then filed Part 2 of their Plans on August 15, 2022.
