UM 2143 Investigation into Resource AdequacyComment Period Announcement

This announcement provides guidelines to submit comments regarding Staff's straw proposal in UM 2143 filed on September 23, 2022, and later corrected on October 5, 2022.

On October 19, 2022, Staff held a workshop with stakeholders to discuss its <u>updated straw proposal</u> in UM 2143, Staff's investigation into resource adequacy in the state of Oregon. At this workshop, Staff described the content of its straw proposal as well as the draft timeline to bring the straw proposal into a rulemaking docket. In the workshop and in the filed straw proposal, Staff included a comment period ending in late November 2022 for stakeholders to weigh in on the straw proposal's content and scope. Following the workshop, <u>Staff requests that stakeholders file comments on Staff's October 5</u> straw proposal by November 21, 2022.

Staff invites stakeholders to weigh in on any part of Staff's updated October 5 straw proposal. However, based on discussion and insights gathered in the workshop, Staff encourages stakeholders to provide comments on the following topics:

- The level of detail that ESSs should be required to show in a future resource adequacy filing.
- How to properly define metrics of a future resource adequacy filing to align it with state resource adequacy goals and regional resource adequacy programs, such as the Western Resource Adequacy Program.
