ROGUE CLIMATE'S REQUEST FOR FINAL PAYMENT OF HB 2475 FUNDING GRANT

Pursuant to Order 23-015 (January 31, 2023) approving Rogue Climate's (RC) proposed budget in this docket, RC is eligible for a funding in the amount of \$2,400.00 from the Interim HB 2475 Intervenor Fund.

for eligible expenses incurred since January 1, 2022. The itemized report is designated Attachment A. Based upon that itemized statement, RC is seeking approval of a final payment in the amount of \$2,400.

The expenses incurred are reasonably and directly related to the issues and positions RC addressed in UM 2211 on behalf of environmental justice residential customers of PacifiCorp, as further indicated in the time descriptions listed in Attachment A. This request seeks a final full payment for the expenses incurred in UM 2211.
