Re: Notice of BellSouth Long Distance Inc. d/b/a AT&T Long Distance Service's Discontinuance of Certain Telephone Services in Oregon

Dear Mr. Conway:

BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Long Distance Service ("BSLD") hereby provides notice to the Commission of its intention to discontinue provision of local exchange services and to amend its Certificate of Authority to relinquish its authority to provide intraexchange (local exchange) switched service and non-switched, private line service (dedicated transmission service) in the state of Oregon. BSLD requests an effective date of December 15, 2013. BSLD desires to retain its authority to provide interexchange telecommunications as a competitive telecommunications provider and will continue to maintain an interexchange Oregon service guide.

The history of BSLD's certificate of authority as a local provider in Oregon is as follows:

- On February 19, 1997 (Order No. 97-066, docket CP 267), BSLD was granted a Certificate of Authority to provide interexchange (toll and operator- assisted) telecommunications service as a competitive provider.
- On July 28, 2005 (Order No. 05-883, docket CP 1290), the authority granted to BSLD by Order No. 97-066, docket CP 267 was cancelled, and BSLD was granted a new Certificate of Authority which granted the same authority in Order No. 05-883 and authority to provide intraexchange (local exchange) switched service and nonswitched, private line (dedicated transmission service) as a competitive provider.
- In a letter dated January 26, 2007, BSLD notified the Commission that it had adopted the new assumed business name of BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Long Distance Service. A copy of the Oregon Secretary of State Certificate of Trade Name was attached with the letter.

BSLD does not currently have any local exchange or non-switched, private line customers, and does not have any numbers assigned to it from NANPA. In addition there are no 9-1-1 service considerations that need to be addressed.
