Dear Ms. Collins,

Sprint Communications Company L.P. (“Sprint”) respectfully provides notice to the Oregon Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) that it has ceased offering competitive telecommunications services requiring certification in Oregon and requests the Commission cancel its certificate of authority.

In Docket CP 1402, Order No. 08-221, entered on April 16, 2008, the Commission approved Sprint’s application to provide local exchange telecommunications service and interexchange services as a competitive provider, canceling and replacing Sprint’s previous certificates of authority to provide these services, which had been granted in Dockets UM 89, CP 209, and CP 210.

Sprint no longer has any customers receiving services requiring a certificate. Therefore, Sprint no longer needs its existing certificate of authority to provide telecommunications services. Accordingly, there are no customers to be notified regarding this request, and cancellation of Sprint’s certificate will have no adverse consequences for consumers in Oregon.
