14	Pursuant to ORCP 36(C)(7) and OAR 860-001-0080, Teleconnect Long Distance		
15	Services and Systems Company ("Teleconnect") and MCI Communications Services, Inc.		
16	d/b/a Verizon Business Services ("MCI") (together "Applicants") move for the entry of the		
17	Public Utility Commission of Oregon's ("C	ommission") general protective order in this	
18	proceeding. Good cause exists to issue a Protective Order to protect commercially sensitive		
19	and confidential business information related to the Applicants' operations in Oregon.		
20	In support of this Motion, the Applicants state:		
21	1. The Commission's rules authorize Applicants to seek reasonable restrictions on		
22	discovery of trade secrets and other confidential business information. See 860-001-0080;		
23	ORCP 36(C)(7) (providing protection against unrestricted discovery of "trade secrets or other		
24	confidential research, development, or commercial information"). See also In re Investigation		
25	into the Cost of Providing Telecommunication Service, Docket UM 351, Order No. 91-500		
26	(1991) (recognizing that protective orders are a reasonable means to protect "the rights of a

2	communication of information between litigants").	
3	2. On September 10, 2014, App	icants filed a redacted version of Notice of
4	Customer Transfer and Request for Waiver pursuant to OAR 860-032-0020. Under that rule,	
5	5 Applicants are required to state the numl	per of customers affected, which information
6	Applicants consider to be confidential. Applic	ants will be exposed to competitive injury if they
7	7 are forced to make unrestricted disclosure	of its confidential business information. "The
8	Commission's standard blanket protective order is designed to facilitate discovery in cases	
9	involving discovery of large numbers of documents." See In re Portland Extended Area	
10	Service Region, Docket UM 261, Order No. 91-958 (1991). Issuance of a protective order will	
11	facilitate the production of relevant information and expedite the discovery process.	
12	For the foregoing reasons, Applicants request entry of a standard Protective Order in	
13	this docket. Once that Protective Order is adopted, Applicants will file an unredacted version	
14	of their Notice of Customer Transfer and Request for Waiver.
