Greeting all,

STOP appreciates the proposed schedule. However, we are concerned at the lack of the public meeting that was included in all the other schedules between Staff/Intervenor Final Comments and Idaho Power Final Comment Reply. See prior schedules below.

It was our understanding that this public meeting was to allow the public to comment on the intervenors' and staff's final comments to help frame issues before Idaho Power's reply comments.

At the opening commission public meeting in Ontario, before one of the "pauses" in the docket, which had to have 2 sessions due to time zone differences, several of the participants expressed their concern and desire for a full public process. Commissioner Thompson ensured the public that there would be three opportunities for the public to give public comment. STOP, does not believe that the intention of 3 public comment meetings for the public on the issues in the docket are being fulfilled; a meeting that happens to be "public" is not the same as the public being invited to make "public comment."

STOP raised questions, in October 2020, about the back to back meetings on October 21 and 22, wondering why they could not be combined. We were informed that the 10/21/20 meeting was by Idaho Power for intervenors. Idaho Power would give an overview of the changes from the amended IRP to the second amended IRP and that intervenors would have a Q and A session, which was informative and appreciated. The next day, 10/22/20, Idaho Power presented a summary of the information for the commissioners. As I recall no public spoke nor were called upon by the commissioners for comments. This was an informational meeting.

The public has not yet been given an opportunity to comment on the second amended IRP nor will they after the staff/intervenor final comments as laid out in the original calendars below.

STOP does not wish to be difficult but is responsible to our members, over 800, who wish to have their voices heard before the final commission decision-making meeting. Waiting for the final commission meeting itself, will be too late to raise issues and comment on staff and interveners' final comments.

Staff will have issued their PM memo, which we think PM means public meeting memo, without a public meeting.

The commission will be making a final decision at the only scheduled public meeting left without hearing from the public before that meeting.

STOP respectfully requests that a public meeting with the commission be scheduled between the Staff/Intervenor Final Comments and Idaho Power Final Comment Reply as in the first two schedules. Or better yet between Idaho Powers Final Comment Reply and the Staff PM Memo. This would allow the public to comment on staff, intervener, and Idaho Powers Final Comment Reply, which we believe, would better inform the Staff PM Memo.
