NEWSUN ENERGY LLC'S REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO
PACIFICORP'S REQUEST FOR
CERTIFICATION

EXPEDITED PROCESSING REQUESTED

NewSun Energy LLC (NewSun) hereby requests a one-week extension of time to file a response to PacifiCorp's Request for Certification of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Katherine Mapes' January 21, 2022 ruling (Ruling) in the above-mentioned docket, which would make the response due March 1, 2022, or such additional time as the ALJ deems appropriate. NewSun understands that parties typically file a response to a request for certification within the 15-day deadline provided for responses to motions at the Oregon Public Utility Commission pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420(4). PacifiCorp filed its Request for Certification of the ALJ Ruling on February 7, 2022, and therefore, the expected due date for a response would be 15 days later, which is today, February 22, 2022. The purpose of the requested extension is to allow time for NewSun to confer with the other parties to the docket and explore the possibility of reaching practical solutions to resolve the dispute.

NewSun contacted all parties on the service list to confer on this request. Counsel for PacifiCorp stated via telephone that PacifiCorp does not take a position on this request. Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition stated via email that it does not oppose this request. The Sierra Club and NW Energy Coalition stated via telephone that those

intervenor parties do not object to this request. Accordingly, NewSun respectfully requests expedited ruling without waiting for responses from the parties.
