Dear Judge Wallace:

On November 2, 2010, ICNU filed a Motion to Amend the Protective Order ("Motion"), in the above referenced docket. On November 17, 2010, PacifiCorp filed a Response in Opposition to ICNU's Motion to Modify the Protective Order ("Response"). On November 29, 2010, PacifiCorp filed a Supplemental Exhibit to its Response. ICNU objects to the Supplemental Exhibit on the grounds that the deadline for filing evidence in opposition to ICNU's Motion has passed. Responses to ICNU's Motion were due fifteen days after the date of service, or November 17, 2010. OAR 860-001-0420(4).

As a practical matter, PacifiCorp's filing constitutes an amendment to its Response. Since the time for submitting responses has passed, PacifiCorp can only amend its Response by filing a Motion seeking leave to amend. A party is entitled to have seven days to file a response to a procedural motion. Id. Likewise, a party may file a reply to a response to a substantive motion within seven days. Id. You have previously determined that the Motion is a substantive motion. Therefore, ICNU requests that you allow ICNU to file a reply to PacifiCorp's amended Response within seven days of service, or December 6, 2010.
