**PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC
COMPANY'S MOTION TO AMEND
THE SCHEDULE**

Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") moves for entry of an order or ruling amending the schedule in this docket. In support of the motion, PGE states as follows:

1. PGE, Staff for the Public Utility Commission ("Staff") and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU") (collectively the "Stipulating Parties") have agreed to a settlement-in-principle, subject to finalization in a written stipulation. The Stipulating Parties therefore request that the schedule in this docket be amended as follows:

Stipulating Parties File Stipulation and Explanatory Brief or Testimony	February 1, 2008
Written Objections, if any, to the Stipulation	February 15, 2008
Reply Comments in Support of the Stipulation	February 22, 2008
Simultaneous Opening Briefs	March 3, 2008
Simultaneous Response Briefs	March 13, 2008

2. The Stipulating Parties believe that briefs are necessary in this docket to address certain issues which the settlement-in-principle does not resolve, namely the amortization period for the adjustment amount determined for PGE's 2006 calendar year and the treatment of PGE's sale of an unregulated asset (an LM 6000 turbine) in calendar-year 2006, described in more detail in PGE's opening testimony. In addition, the Stipulating


Parties believe that shortening the time for comments on the Stipulation from 20 days, as provided by Commission rule, to 14 days is reasonable and necessary in light of the statutorily imposed deadline for a Commission final order in this docket. ORS 757.268(4).

3. The Stipulating Parties have conferred with the other parties in this docket. None of the parties in this docket oppose this Motion to Amend the Schedule in this docket.

For the above-stated reasons, Portland General Electric Company requests entry of an order or ruling amending the schedule in this docket as suggested above.
