STAFF MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULE

Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“Staff”) moves for entry of an order or ruling amending the schedule in this docket. In support of the motion, Staff states as follows:

1. Staff and Portland General Electric Company (PGE) (collectively the “Stipulating Parties”) are filing today a stipulation with supporting testimony. Accordingly, the Stipulating Parties request that dates be added to the schedule for written objections, if any, to the stipulation.

2. Because the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”) has filed testimony raising issues not specifically related to the Stipulation, the Stipulation Parties believe that the schedule in this docket should continue to provide for PGE’s rebuttal testimony, a hearing, and simultaneous legal briefs. The Stipulating Parties request no change in the schedule related to those current deadlines. The Stipulating Parties therefore request that the schedule in this docket be amended to reflect the following:
