7	Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("staff") asks the hearing officer to		
8	allow staff and intervenors an additional week in which to file testimony in response to Portland		
9	General Electric Company's ("PGE") Response to Bench Requests and to allow PGE a		
10	corresponding additional week in which to file rebuttal testimony. Staff does not request that		
11	the hearing date be moved, which is currently scheduled 31 days after PGE files its rebuttal		
12	testimony. Counsel for staff has contacted counsel for the Industrial Customers of Northwest		
13	Utilities, the Citizens' Utility Board, and PGE and none of these parties object to staff's		
14	requested schedule modification.		
15	Staff asks for the extension because its witness will be out of the state for three days next		
16	week, the week that testimony is due, in order to attend a funeral of a family member. His		
17	departure makes it difficult for staff to complete and finalize the testimony prior to the due date.		
18	The current schedule contemplates that PGE will file its testimony 31 days prior to the		
19	date scheduled for hearing. Accordingly, the proposed modification can occur without a change		
20	to the hearing date because even if the modification is allowed, there will still be 24 days		
21	between PGE's rebuttal testimony and the hearing.
