8	Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420 and OAR 860-001-0350, PacifiCorp, Staff of the		
9	Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff), the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB), and		
10	Noble Americas Energy Solutions LLC (Noble Solutions) (together, the Parties) submit this		
11	motion (Motion) to the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission). In this Motion, the		
12	Parties request that the Commission take the following actions to facilitate review of the		
13	Parties' comprehensive Stipulation, which the Parties are filing concurrently with this Motion:		
14	(1) reopen the record in this proceeding to accept the Stipulation and Joint Testimony		
15	supporting the Stipulation into the record, as well as any additional evidence the Commission		
16	deems necessary to its evaluation of the Stipulation; (2) allow the filing of the Stipulation and		
17	Joint Testimony; and (3) amend the schedule in this case as proposed below to provide for		
18	additional process to evaluate the Stipulation, or hold a scheduling conference to set a new		
19	procedural schedule.		
20	The Parties contacted the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) to confer		
21	on the Motion. ICNU opposes the schedule proposed in the Motion and provided an		
22	alternative proposed schedule which adds two dates: a hearing date of October 24 and a		
23	post-hearing briefing date of November 7 or 8. While the Joint Parties do not object to adding		
24	these milestones, ICNU's proposed schedule is not sufficiently expedited to allow for a		
25	decision on the Stipulation prior to the commencement of the direct access window.		
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1 **BACKGROUND** 2 This case went to hearing before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Lisa Hardie on 3 September 8, 2011. After the hearing, all parties to the docket participated in an additional 4 settlement conference on September 14, 2011. This settlement conference resulted in a 5 comprehensive settlement of all issues in the case among the Parties. ICNU, the only other 6 party to this docket, participated in the settlement conference but declined to join the 7 Stipulation. 8 MOTION 9 To allow for the process necessary for the Commission to review this Stipulation, the 10 Parties request that the Commission take the following actions: 11 1. Reopen the record in this proceeding; 12 2. Allow the Stipulation and supporting Joint Testimony filed concurrently with this 13 Motion to be filed in this proceeding:<sup>1</sup> 14 3. Amend the schedule in this case as follows: 15 Vacate the existing briefing schedule; a. 16 b. Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0350(8), set October 5, 2011 (15 days from the 17 date of this filing) as the deadline for ICNU to file written objections to the 18 Stipulation and to request a hearing on the Stipulation; 19 Allow the Parties to file a response to the objections by October 14, 2011; C. 20 d. Set a date for hearing or oral argument if deemed necessary; and 21 e. Set October 31, 2011 as the target date for a final order in this docket. 22 An order by this date is necessary to allow PacifiCorp to incorporate the 23

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The Parties did not submit affidavits with this Motion because of the possibility that the
 Commission will hold a hearing on the Stipulation. In the event a hearing is not required, the Partles will submit affidavits in support of the joint testimony.

1	Commission's order into the Company's Indicative Filing on November 8,		
2	2011 and the Final Update on November 15, 2011.		
3	The Parties request that the Commission reopen the record, accept the filing of the		
4	Stipulation and Joint Testimony, and adopt the Parties' proposed schedule or hold a		
5	scheduling conference to set a new schedule.		
6	CONCLUSION		
7	To ensure orderly review of the Parties' comprehensive Stipulation, the Parties request		
8	that the Commission take the actions outlined above.
