For the reasons set out below, Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) hereby requests that the remaining procedural schedule in this docket be suspended.

Two Stipulations have been filed in this docket that together settled all issues except PGE’s pension-related costs. On August 6, 2013, Staff of the Public Utility Commission (“Staff”), the Citizens’ Utility Board (“CUB”), and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (“ICNU”), filed rebuttal testimony addressing only test-year pension costs. PGE filed surrebuttal testimony on August 28, 2013. No other party filed testimony regarding pension costs.

Settlement discussions between PGE, Staff, CUB and ICNU (collectively the “Stipulating Parties”) were held on August 16, 2013, and continued on September 5, 2013. As a result of those discussions, an agreement in principal resolving the one remaining issue of test-year pension costs was reached among the Stipulating Parties. The Stipulating Parties are in the process of completing a stipulation and supporting joint testimony and anticipate filing the stipulation and testimony later this week.

PGE respectfully requests that the remaining procedural schedule in this docket be suspended.¹ With this third stipulation to be filed shortly, PGE will have entered into


stipulations that resolve all issues raised by the parties in this rate case. PGE therefore believes that the hearing and briefing dates remaining in this docket will not be necessary.

CONCLUSION AND EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUEST

For the reasons discussed above, PGE requests that the administrative law judge issue an order suspending the remaining procedural schedule in this docket. Pursuant to the schedule set in this docket, cross-examination statements and each party's prehearing memorandum are due tomorrow. Accordingly, expedited consideration of this motion is requested.


