DESIGNATION OF PGE EXHIBITS FOR
CONSIDERATION IN THIS DOCKET

8 On March 7, 2013, staff of the Public Utility Commission (“staff”) asked the
9 Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) to move issues related to Portland General Electric Company’s
10 net variable power costs (NVPC) to a separate docket so that parties and the Commission could
11 consider these issues on an expedited basis. Specifically, staff asked the ALJ “to issue an order
12 opening a docket to address issues related to PGE’s NVPC and APCU and noting the parties’
13 understanding that such issues are addressed in PGE Exhibits 400, 401, 402 and Schedule 125
14 currently included in PGE’s General Rate Request.”

15 On March 11, 2013, the ALJ granted staff’s motion. Issues related to PGE’s NVPC are
16 now presented in this docket. The ALJ has ordered the parties to Docket No. UE 266 to submit a
17 joint filing “designat[ing] which testimony from the general rate revision docket UE 262 should
18 be transferred or copied into this docket.”

19 On March 28, 2013, counsel for staff e-mailed the UE 262/266 service lists stating that it
20 proposed to file a motion designating Schedule 125 and PGE Exhibits 400, 401, and 402, as
21 exhibits filed in Docket No. UE 266.¹ Staff asked parties to respond by 2 p.m. on March 29,
22 2013, with any objection. Both PGE and the Citizens’ Utility Board of Oregon responded in
23 support of staff’s proposal. No party objected.

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¹ Staff also noted that to the extent any party later identified other exhibits filed in Docket No.
26 UE 262 that are relevant to Docket No. UE 266, the party could ask that the exhibits be
designated as exhibits filed in Docket No. UE 266.

1 PGE asked, however, that staff include the following statement in the joint filing: "The
2 outcome of UE 266 will be reflected in the energy pricing used to estimate the transition
3 adjustments for the November 15 direct access window and in the UE 262 compliance filing."


4 **CONCLUSION**

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
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
