MOTION TO SUSPEND NON-POWER COST PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND ADOPT SCHEDULE FOR REMAINING ISSUE

EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUESTED

For the reasons set out below, Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") hereby requests that the Administrative Law Judge issue a ruling:

- 1. Suspending the remaining procedural schedule for non-power cost issues, and
- 2. Adopting a proposed schedule to address the single power cost issue remaining in this docket.

On July 14, 2014, PGE filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule for Power Costs. That motion indicated that all parties that had raised power cost issues had reached a settlement of all power cost issues except one. The motion further stated that the parties would propose to the Administrative Law Judge an expedited schedule to address the one remaining issue. PGE requested expedited consideration because Staff and Intervenor testimony was due that day. Also on July 14, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge issued a ruling suspending the power cost schedule.

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Parties to the docket continued settlement discussions, and on July 17, 2015, reached settlement of all remaining revenue requirement and rate spread and rate design issues. PGE, Staff of the Public Utility Commission, the Citizens' Utility Board, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, the Kroger Company, and the Small Business Utility Advocates (collectively the "Stipulating Parties") participated in the settlement discussions. No other party filed testimony in this docket. As a result, all issues in the docket have been settled except the one remaining power cost issue.

The parties propose the following schedule to address the remaining power cost issue:
