**PACIFICORP'S REVISED MOTION
FOR ADDITIONAL PROTECTION**

5 On October 23, 2007, PacifiCorp submitted a motion for additional protection
6 seeking a limited set of documents to be protected as part of that motion. Based on recent
7 developments, PacifiCorp believes that an expansion of its original request is required.
8 Therefore, PacifiCorp would like to modify its original request and hereby requests that
9 the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issue another Protective Order that would allow the
10 qualified signatories to review commercially sensitive, non-public information, including
11 bid scoring and evaluation results, submitted by PacifiCorp as part of a justification
12 memorandum supporting amendment of its 2012 request for proposal (2012 RFP), and
13 any other highly sensitive, non-public information submitted by parties in this proceeding
14 related to the 2012 RFP.

15 Consistent with its original motion, the Company submits that in order to
16 maintain the competitive integrity of the 2012 RFP and the bid evaluation process, the
17 highly sensitive, non-public information should be disclosed in Oregon only to the
18 Commissioners, the Staff, the IEs and non-bidding parties who execute a modified
19 protective order. The Company contends that disclosing any of the information
20 surrounding the bid evaluation process and the status of the bids could prove detrimental
21 to the integrity of the 2012 RFP process and jeopardize the bidders and the Company's
22 competitive positions. Moreover, the Commission has already acknowledged in Order

1 No. 06-446 that any bidding information, including detailed bid scoring and evaluation
2 results should be limited to the Commission, the Commission Staff and non-bidding
3 parties under protective orders that limit use of the information to RFP approval and
4 acknowledgement and to cost recovery proceedings. *See* Order No. 06-446, Guidelines
5 12 and 11.

6 Consistent with Order No. 06-446 and in accordance with paragraph 16 of the
7 Protective Order, the Company specifically requests that this provision of its original
8 motion be modified to read and that the ALJ issue an order with language substantially in
9 the form of the following:


- 10 • This order governs the acquisition and use of “Non-Public Information”
11 which is highly sensitive and confidential information submitted by parties
12 in this proceeding related to PacifiCorp’s 2012 RFP.

13 PacifiCorp reincorporates the remaining provisions of its original motion
14 submitted on October 23, 2007.

15 Conclusion

16 Based upon the foregoing, Pacific Power respectfully requests that the
17 ALJ grant its revised motion for additional protective measures and issue an
18 order containing the additional protective measures set forth herein.


