# IDAHO POWER COMPANY'S MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULE

In the Prehearing Conference Report dated October 2, 2006, Administrative Law Judge Traci Kirkpatrick (the "ALJ") adopted a schedule in this case including a Workshop set for December 4, 2006.
