9	On July 6, 2009, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Allan Arlow modified the			
10	schedule in this proceeding to provide that the companies file supplemental testimony on			
11	July 23, 2009. Since that time, PacifiCorp, Staff, the Citizens' Utility Board ("CUB"), and			
12	the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU") have been working to come to			
13	settlement on various issues in this docket.	These parties are currently in the process of		
14	finalizing a partial settlement. In the event that the parties reach a partial settlement,			
15	PacifiCorp will not need to file supplemental testimony on certain issues that are the			
16	subject of settlement.			
17	PacifiCorp requests that the Commis	sion extend the time for PacifiCorp's filing of		
18	supplemental testimony by one day—to July	24, 2009. Staff, CUB, and ICNU do not		
19	oppose this request. This one-day delay will facilitate finalization of a partial settlement			
20	and a reduction in the scope of its supplemental testimony.			
21	PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission approve this extension of the			
22	time for PacifiCorp filing supplemental testim	ony by one day to July 24, 2009. The rest of
