Renewable Northwest Project ("RNP") and Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon ("CUB") move the Commission for an order requesting that (1) the parties in this docket submit supplemental comments on recent solar installed-cost data, and (2) PUC Staff submit a rate table (Appendix B of Staff's final comments) that incorporates a revised range of installed costs. This motion is unopposed by Staff, the Energy Trust of Oregon ("ETO"), the Oregon Solar Energy Industries Association, SunEdison, Tanner Creek Energy, SolarCity, Portland General Electric, and Idaho Power.

To ensure that the timeline for filing additional comments will not significantly delay the Commission's decision-making process, RNP also requests that the Commission set an expedited schedule for the supplemental comments and limit the comments only to issues related directly to the Volumetric Incentive Rate (VIR). The proposed timeline for submitting opening supplemental comments is April 9, 2010, with closing comments due April 16, 2010. The proposed PUC order on the VIRs is May 7, 2010.

RNP respectfully requests that the Commission continue its current timeline to issue an order on all of the other issues in the docket to ensure that the key program implementation

components are developed to make the programs available to customers no later than July 1, 2010

(HB 3690 § 3).

RNP, along with several other parties including Staff and CUB, is concerned that the

installed-cost data used to develop Staff's proposed VIRs may not reflect the current market trends

in Oregon. Staff's proposed VIRs are based on an analysis that incorporated ETO data from 2008

and the first three quarters of 2009. Recent conversations with ETO and a sampling of residential

and commercial solar developers has lead RNP to believe there has been a significant decline in

installed costs in the last quarter of 2009 and the first quarter of 2010.

To ensure the program's initial VIR reflects the most up-to-date range of installed costs,

Staff needs a clear process by which it can receive updated installed-cost data and then provide that

data to the Commission. RNP believes that the best process is for the Commission to ask the

parties to provide supplemental comments on recent solar installed-cost data, and for Staff to revise

its rate table to reflect a wider range of installed costs.

For the foregoing reasons, the motion should be allowed.
