EXPEDITED MOTION FOR GENERAL PROTECTIVE ORDER

**Expedited Consideration Requested** 

Under ORCP 36(C)(7) and OAR 860-001-0080(1), PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power 1 2 (PacifiCorp or Company) moves the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) for 3 entry of a general protective order in the Company's Application to Update Schedule 37 4 Qualifying Facility Information proceeding. Good cause exists to issue a Protective Oder to 5 protect commercially sensitive and confidential business information in this proceeding. 6 The Commission's rules authorize PacifiCorp to seek reasonable restrictions on discovery of trade secrets and other confidential business information. The Commission's 7 8 general protective order is designed to allow the broadest possible discovery consistent with the need to protect confidential information.<sup>2</sup> PacifiCorp requests this protective order to 9 10 facilitate the communication of information between the parties and expedite the discovery 11 process.
