MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE

9 Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) asks the Administrative Law
10 Judge (ALJ) to modify the procedural schedule in the above-caption docket. The Staff witness
11 has been ill for the last several days and Staff is unable to complete and finalize her testimony
12 prior to the October 8, 2015 due date. When Staff proposed to other parties to postpone the due
13 dates for all testimony out by one week to accommodate this requested change to the October 8,
14 2015 testimony due date, other parties responded with suggested modifications to the procedural
15 schedule that ensure there is adequate time to prepare all of the filings in light of the holidays
16 that occur in December and January and that include due dates for cross-examination statements
17 and exhibits.

18 The following is the proposed scheduled agreed to by Staff, PacifiCorp, Renewable NW,
19 Community Renewable Energy Association (CREA), Renewable Energy Coalition (REC),
20 Obsidian Renewables, LLC, Sierra Club, Northwest Energy Coalition (NWECC), Cypress Creek
21 Renewables, LLC, the City of Portland, the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE), and
22 Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC).

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
