Strata Solar Development, LLC's Petition to allow its Sur-Reply and Sur-Reply to Portland General Electric Company's Motion for Interim Relief

Strata Solar Development, LLC (Strata) petition's the Commission to allow its brief Sur-Reply on one matter pleaded in Portland General Electric Company's (PGE's) August 3 Reply: whether PGE is continuing to timely process Schedule 201 PPA applications during this proceeding. Strata respectfully suggests that there is evidence that PGE is not following the timelines in Schedule 201. Specifically, Strata disputes PGE's assertion that, per the Schedule 201 timelines, PGE will not be required to provide executable PPAs prior to the Commission ruling on its Motion for Interim Relief.

Although the rules do not authorize this Sur-Reply, the Commission has allowed such pleadings where it found the information helpful and otherwise appropriate. Here, PGE asserted in its Reply that there is no evidence PGE is failing to adhere to Schedule 201

and Schedule 202 timelines.² Because PGE first raised the issue of timeliness in its Reply, other parties did not have an opportunity to be heard on the issue. Strata wishes to dispute PGE's assertion and provides the attached Affidavit of its West Regional Director, John Knight, in support of its position. Under these circumstances it would be fair and appropriate to note that there is evidence that PGE has not followed the Schedule 201 timelines in processing pending Schedule 201 applications.

Conclusion

For the reasons above, Strata respectfully requests that the Commission allow this Sur-Reply and accompanying Affidavit of John Knight.

- 1 Q. Did you previously submit an affidavit in this Docket on July 27, 2017 in
- 2 support of Strata Solar Development, LLC's (Strata's) Response?
- 3 A. Yes.
- 4 Q. What is the purpose of this affidavit?
- 5 A. To rebut PGE's assertion, in its August 3 Reply, that Schedule 201 timelines do not
- 6 require PGE to provide executable power purchase agreements before the
- 7 Commission issues a decision on its motion for interim relief.

1	Q.	Please provide examples where PGE did not adhere to the Schedule 201
2		timelines:
3	A:	PGE does not follow Schedule 201 which, provides: "When both parties are in full
4		agreement as to all terms and conditions of the draft Standard PPA, the Company
5		will prepare and forward to the Seller a final executable version of the agreement
6		within 15 business days." Schedule 201, Sheet 201-2 (June 1, 2017). In several
7		instances, PGE has refused to send Strata a final executable PPA until after it sends a
8		final draft PPA which Strata agrees is 100% correct. By insisting on another cycle of
9		PPA drafting after the QF has agreed to all terms and conditions in the Draft PPA,
10		PGE has added at least 15 unauthorized business days to the Schedule 201 PPA
11		approval process timeline.
12	Q.	How is this relevant to PGE's August 3 Reply?
13	A:	Because Strata has pending Schedule 201 PPA requests for executable PPAs where
14		PGE's tactic may be determinative. In several instances, Strata requested final
15		executable PPAs shortly after PGE filed its June 30, 2017 Motion for Interim Relief.
16		Strata contends that PGEs wrongful application of Schedule 201 rules prior to June
17		30, 2017 delayed the point where Strata and PGE reached full agreement on the
18		terms of several QF PPA requests. Nevertheless, where PGE and Strata agreed upon
19		all terms and conditions of the draft PPA in early July, PGE still has not provided a

final executable PPA. In fact, it has notified Strata that it does not plan to send it an

executable PPA prior to the Commission issuing its decision. In sum, Strata believes

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- PGE owed it final executable PPAs for multiple QF projects at the time PGE filed its
