The modification to the procedural schedule is necessary because, due to an unexpected scheduling conflict, the parties were not able to convene for the settlement conference that was scheduled for December 7, 2017, but still wish to convene a settlement conference prior to the filing of intervenor and Staff testimony, which is currently due on January 19, 2018. The schedule proposed in this motion provides a new date for a settlement conference and revises the
