RE: UM 1953 – PGE’s Proposal for Phase II Schedule

As directed by Commission Order No. 19-075 in Docket No. UM 1953, PGE submits this proposed Phase II procedural schedule for the consideration of parties.

In Phase II, PGE will revisit the applicability of the nine conditions originally outlined in Orders No 15-405 and 16-251 in the current environment, including the interaction between the Green Tariff and Oregon’s Direct Access program. Phase II may also address the long-term credit calculation mechanism and whether incremental credits should be allowed in either a floating or fixed credit scenario.

PGE is targeting a Commission order date in January 2020 so that the next Green Tariff offering may be available to customers in early 2020. PGE is sensitive to the frustration and inconvenience customers may experience if enrolling customers quickly fill the 100 MW participation cap and others are not able to participate in the first PGE Green Tariff offering. Therefore, to the extent possible, PGE aims to expedite the availability of its next offering. This timing would also enable PGE customers to take advantage of the enhanced economics of wind and solar projects qualifying for the Production Tax Credits and Incentive Tax Credits, before those credits are phased out.
