**EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION
REQUESTED**

The Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, the Renewable Energy Coalition, and the Community Renewable Energy Association (collectively, the “Interconnection Customer Coalition”) hereby move the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (the “Commission”) Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) for an extension of time for Staff and Intervenors to file Response Testimony in this proceeding. Specifically, movants request that the deadline is moved from October 19, 2020 to October 30, 2020.

The Interconnection Customer Coalition contacted the other parties in this case. Staff and NewSun Energy support this motion. The Alliance of Western Energy Consumers does not oppose this motion. The Joint Utilities have agreed to the extension of time on the condition that the parties would work to develop a mutually agreeable schedule that allows adequate time for subsequent rounds of testimony and briefing and avoids scheduling conflicts. The Interconnection Customer Coalition believe the Joint Utilities’ conditions are reasonable and agree to them.

The Interconnection Customer Coalition request expedited consideration of this motion.
