JOINT MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULE

VS.

Expedited Consideration Requested

PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY,

Defendant.

On April 7, 2020, Complainant Zena Solar, LLC ("Zena Solar") and Defendant Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") filed a joint motion to extend deadlines. The motion asked the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("Commission") to modify several deadlines in this case to give the parties more time to negotiate a mutually agreed procedural schedule. On April 8, 2020, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Christopher Allwein issued a ruling approving the extended deadlines requested by the parties. The parties have reached agreement on a procedural schedule and now jointly move the Commission and ALJ Allwein to approve that schedule.

Under the agreed procedural schedule, the parties are asking the Commission to:

- 1. Extend the end date of the temporary interim relief period from April 30, 2020, to June 19, 2020;
- 2. Extend PGE's deadline to respond to Zena Solar's motion for interim relief and preliminary injunction from April 24, 2020, to May 29, 2020 (and to eliminate the deadline in favor of the deadlines found in Path 2 if the parties agreed to pursue a consolidated and expedited resolution of the merits and the motion for interim relief and preliminary injunction under Path 2 outlined below);
- 3. Maintain PGE's current deadline to answer the complaint on April 29, 2020;
- 4. Set May 13, 2020, as the deadline for Zena Solar to respond to any counterclaims PGE may assert in its response to the complaint; and
- 5. Set May 15, 2020, as the deadline for the parties to elect which procedural path they will pursue, either: (A) Path 1 which involves first resolving the motion for interim

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relief and preliminary injunction by June 19, 2020; or (B) Path 2 which involves the consolidated and expedited resolution of the merits of this case and the motion for interim relief and preliminary injunction, as authorized by ORCP 79 C(2). If both parties agree to pursue Path 2 and file a statement to that effect on or before May 15, 2020, then the schedule will follow Path 2; otherwise, the schedule will follow Path 1.

More specifically, the parties respectfully request that the Commission or its ALJ approve the following procedural schedule:

Path 1 – Resolve Motion for Interim Relief and Preliminary Injunction ("PI Motion") First

May 29, 2020	PGE response to PI Motion
June 5, 2020	Zena reply re PI Motion
June 9, 2020	Parties indicate whether they agree to waive hearing on PI Motion
Week of June 15	Hearing on PI Motion (if not waived)
June 19, 2020	Decision on PI Motion
June 24, 2020	Prehearing conference regarding remaining schedule

Path 2 – Consolidated and Expedited Resolution of Merits and PI Motion

May 15, 2020	Temporary interim relief extended to August 14, 2020, and deadline
	to respond to data requests shortened to 7-calendar-days
May 21, 2020	Parties submit stipulated facts
June 8, 2020	Simultaneous opening briefs and testimony/declarations
July 1, 2020	Simultaneous response briefs and testimony/declarations
July 15, 2020	Simultaneous reply briefs
July 17, 2020	Parties indicate whether they waive a live hearing
Week of July 27	Hearing, if not waived
August 14, 2020	Decision on the merits and on the PI Motion

The parties believe this procedural schedule will facilitate the orderly and efficient resolution of this case. Neither party waives its rights to a more traditional procedural schedule in other proceedings.

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The parties respectfully request that ALJ Allwein approve the above procedural schedule by April 20, 2020.
