ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of Portland General Electric Company ("PGE"), as shown in Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in PGE's Application for a Declaratory Ruling Regarding the Application of OAR 860-022-0045 and OAR 860-021-0135. ICNU's members are among the customers from which PGE is collecting in rates amounts for the Multnomah County Business Income Tax. As a result, the manner in which PGE charges customers for local income taxes has a direct effect on the rates paid by many of ICNU's members. In addition, if the Commission determines that PGE has incorrectly charged customers for local taxes, then the Commission's decision regarding the application of OAR 860-021-0135 to any overbilling that has occurred will impact ICNU members' rights.

5. ICNU represents the interests of a number of large electric customers in the State of Oregon. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.
