Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") filed its Integrated Resource Plan 4 with the Commission on November 5, 2009, pursuant to Commission Order No. 08-246 in 5 Docket No. LC 43, and Commission Order No. 07-002 in Docket No. UM 1056.
