Several CADO and OECA member agencies deliver programs and services to low-income customers of Portland General Electric that are attempting to make timely payment of their bills and/or are qualified for low-income weatherization assistance.

4. CADO and OECA have a substantial interest in this matter as the issues surrounding the development and deployment of Advanced Metering Infrastructure systems and devices will have both direct and secondary impact on PGE's low-income ratepayers.

CADO and OECA believe that our past experience in intervening in OPUC utility application such as UM 1209, UM 1121, UE 102, UM 918, UG 143, our efforts in helping to develop and shape low-income bill payment assistance and weatherization programs, and our efforts that impacted the development of electric restructuring legislation (SB 1149) provide expertise that will assist the Commission in their consideration of this matter.
