3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of PacifiCorp, as shown on Attachment A.

4. ICNU has a substantial interest in PacifiCorp's Application for its 2010 Transition Adjustment Mechanism ("Application"). PacifiCorp filed its Application on March 30, 2009. The transition adjustment proposes to increase the rates that PacifiCorp provides to ICNU's members that remain on cost of service rates.

5. ICNU has extensive experience with PacifiCorp's rates and previous transition adjustment mechanisms. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.
