3. ICNU is an incorporated, non-profit association of large industrial electric customers in the Pacific Northwest, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of ICNU members is included as Attachment A. Many of ICNU's members are customers of Portland General Electric ("PGE"), as shown on Attachment A. ICNU represents the interests of many of PGE's largest customers.

4. On July 1, 2009, PGE filed testimony and new tariffs associated with its 2008 Power Cost Variance ("PCV") Mechanism. The proposed rate change under the terms of PGE's 2008 PCV Mechanism would substantially and directly affect those of ICNU's members who purchase power from PGE. As a result, ICNU has a substantial interest in this proceeding. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who are affected by the operation of PGE's 2008 PCV Mechanism.

5. ICNU has extensive experience with PGE's rates and with previous proceedings related to PGE's PCV mechanism. ICNU's intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with these proceedings. It is in the public interest to allow ICNU to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, ICNU respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
